



Actions / Works in progress:

2021- Requalification Project of the CDNJ Shooting Range Parking Lot – The CDNJ Shooting Range parking lot was conditioned, due to a significant extension of damaged spaces, largely as a result of the superficial growth of the roots of the arboreal specimens. This requalification will make it possible to enhance the use, appropriation and profitability of existing assets, creating favorable conditions to host events and receive all types of users. It was necessary to remove the arboreal specimens with compromised stages of development, either because of competition with adjacent tree elements, or because of conformation and structure problems, which led to the deterioration of the pavements, in order to guarantee the safeguarding of people and goods. At the same time, an improvement was sought in the installation's landscape framing, by creating a tree curtain with 24 European nettle trees (*Celtis australis*), deciduous trees, used in urban areas, which provide good shading and are suitable for parking areas. The choice of new copies took into account the problems that were at the origin of the current situation.

Another 50 new trees will also be planted in the area of the forest parcel adjacent to the parking lot, with 3 different species being planted: cork oaks, *Acer campestre* and *Ginkgo Biloba*. With the introduction of these new species, the objective is to ensure the creation of a more diversified space and contribute to the increase of its biodiversity.
